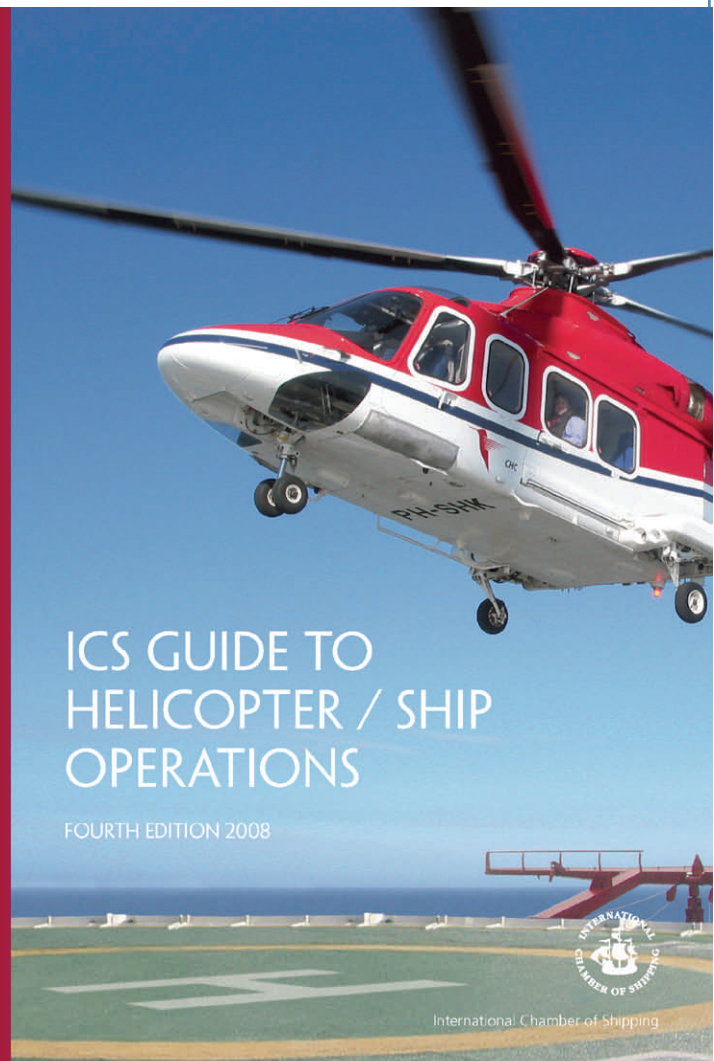
To provide additional value and utility, this new edition is accompanied by a **CD version** of the text with a **'search'** function.
